“Discipline by a licensing agency in any state, federal, or foreign jurisdiction” means discipline reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank. ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION THAT WOULD BE REQUIRED TO BE REPORTED TO THE NATIONAL PRACTITIONER DATA BANK (NPDB). THIS INCLUDED (chg to INCLUDES) DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS THAT WERE NOT REPORTED TO THE NPDB BUT WERE REQUIRED TO BE REPORTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH NPDB REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AND DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS IMPOSED BY INTERNATIONAL LICENSING BODIES, EVEN IF THOSE ENTITIES ARE UNABLE TO SUBMIT REPORTS TO THE NPDB DUE TO JURISDICTIONAL LIMITATIONS.

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
