The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission (IMLCC) is pleased to announce that North Carolina has recently joined.

On Tuesday, July 1, 2025, Governor Josh Stein signed into law House Bill 67 / Session Law 2025-37 making North Carolina the 44<sup>th</sup> member jurisdiction.

Since operations began in April 2017, there have been over 130,000 licenses issued through the IMLCC process, helping over 26,000 physicians.

The IMLCC now has 42 states, the District of Columbia, and the Territory of Guam as member jurisdictions. There is currently legislation pending in 1 state – Massachusetts.
